What is Care Coordination?

Care coordination is:

"A needs driven, team-based process that values families as essential partners."

Care coordination is intended to integrate care among multiple service providers, enhance the caregiving ability of the family, and maximize the potential of the child".

The purpose of this one day training is to help parents learn:

- How to navigate health care and insurance systems
- Skills to increase communication and coordination among multiple providers
- How to plan early for transition to adult healthcare
- Ideas for coping with stress and finding peer support
- Ways to advocate for improved care

This training is open to any Michigan parent (biological, step, foster, adoptive, or kinship) or legal guardian of a child or youth (birth-18) who has epilepsy (seizure disorder) OR other special health care needs.
