As the fallout from the Covid-19 pandemic continues to impact the lives of people with disabilities, MI-UCP would like to share with you the 2022 Case for Inclusion, Blazing Trails to Sustainability for Community Disability Services.

This year's report centers around the direct support professional crisis. This crisis is nothing new to advocates, as we have faced a steady decline in the availability of direct support professionals over the past decade. This is primarily due to the stagnant reimbursement rates and the rising cost of care. Service providers and people wishing to hire their own direct support professionals cannot offer competitive wages or health insurance and are losing staff to other hourly wage industries such as fast food.
