

EXPLORING EXPERIENCES OF INJUSTICES EXPERIENCED BY CHILDREN DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

We are seeking participants for a research study. We are looking to hear from service providers of children (e.g., therapists, teachers, social workers, physicians, community health workers, project officers, etc.) working among children from communities experiencing marginalization (e.g., children with disabilities, children experiencing homelessness, poverty, food insecurity, etc.) from around the globe.

Research participants will engage as collaborators to explore how the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has heightened situations of inequity and marginalization among children in relation to their everyday activities.

Participation in this study is voluntary. If you are interested in participating, you will participate in 4-6 group meetings via Zoom for approximately 2 hours each with other service providers (or individual interviews if preferred) as well as additional asynchronous online discussions if desired. Total time commitment is a maximum of 14 hours.

As this research will be conducted virtually, there is a potential risk of loss of confidentiality in all email, downloading, electronic meetings and internet transactions.
