## March and April Benefits Update

Households receiving SNAP\* benefits in Michigan that are **not currently receiving the maximum** amount allowed per household size, will receive an additional amount to raise benefits to the maximum for March and April.

- **March** additional benefits will be issued by **March 30th**
- **April** additional benefits will be issued the day after you regularly receive your normal benefits amount.

If your household currently receives the maximum benefits amount allowed for your household size already, you will not receive any additional benefits at this time.

To see if your household currently receives less than the maximum benefits amount for your household size, please use this chart:
