

## Michigan Report: 2017 National Core Indicators (NCI) Adult In-Person Survey Outcomes

## WHAT IS NCI?

NCI is a national survey used by developmental disabilities agencies in 46 states to evaluate the outcomes of services provided to individuals and families.

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## In 2017, 650 individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities, who received services from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services were randomly selected to complete the NCI Adult In-Person Survey. The average age of the respondent is **42 years**.





2 out of 10 use self-determination



2 out of 10 have paid jobs in the community





7 out of 10 went out for entertainment at least once in the past month

5 out of 10 have some input in where they live



3 out 10 have healthy Body Mass Index (BMI)
