



Michigan Report: 2017 National Core Indicators (NCI) Adult In-Person Survey Outcomes

In 2017, 650 individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities, who received services from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services were randomly selected to complete the NCI Adult In-Person Survey. The average age of the respondent is **42 years**.

WHAT IS NCI?

NCI is a national survey used by developmental disabilities agencies in 46 states to evaluate the outcomes of services provided to individuals and families.
