

Voting Tips

Plan Ahead

Do You Qualify to Vote?

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Be a resident of Michigan, and of the city/township you're registering in.
- Be at least 18 years old by the next election date.
- NOT currently imprisoned for a felony offense.
- Guardianship does NOT take away your right to vote.



Where is Your Polling Location?

Hours, Address, Transportation, Accessibility, Parking

Are You Registered?

- Yes..... Awesome!
- No..... Register to vote in PERSON or by MAIL 30 days before the election!
- I Don't Know..... canivote.org

Have You Recently Moved?

- You must re-register to vote every time you move to a new city or township in MI.

Election Day

ID - Have the proper identification in hand

- Driver's license or ID card
- U.S. passport
- Military ID card
- Student identification
- Tribal ID card



If you don't have ID, you can sign an affidavit.

Assistance

- Bring someone to help you vote (family member, friend, caregiver).
- You can bring your service dog to the polling location.
- You ARE NOT allowed to bring your employer or union rep.



Deadlines

- Primary Election: **Aug. 7, 2018**
- Voter Registration Deadline: **July 9, 2018**
- General Election: **Nov. 6, 2018**
- Voter Registration Deadline: **Oct. 9, 2018**

Long Lines

Be to your polling location as early as possible to avoid long lines.



Accessibility

Ask to use the accessible voting machine if you need accommodations.
